- 2. Pastor Riddle talked about 'The Gospel' and that "We are more sinful and flawed in ourselves than we ever dared believe, yet at the very same time we are more loved and accepted in Jesus Christ than we ever dared hope." What does this mean to you?
- 3. One of Jonathan's points was "No matter our circumstances we can always choose to praise God." Can you give examples of this in your life?
- 4. "Everything we do teaches." The prisoners and jailer were closely watching Paul & Silas, and how they conducted their lives gave witness to who God is. Do you feel like Christians and the church are conducting their lives in a way that gives witness to "The Gospel"?
- 5. What can you do to be a part of witnessing to the world who Jesus Christ is through love & sacrifice?

Point to Ponder: Do people know you as a follower of Jesus Christ, or do they know you better for a life apart from faith- sports, politics, philosophical ideologies?
