- 1. As Christians, how we handle our tongues deserves attention.
 - a. What are the three images James uses in the text to illustrate the power of our tongues?
 - b. Recall a time when someone's words had a positive impact on you and a time when your words impacted someone positively.
 - c. Recall a time when someone's words had a negative impact on you and a time when your words impacted someone negatively.
 - d. In b. and c. above, what was the big impact the small words exchanged had on you? On others?
- 2. In Matthew 15:19 ESV, Jesus enumerates seven forms of deadly poison that are often spewed from our mouths. What are they?
 - a. In the previous verse, Jesus says these forms of verbal poison reveal what's in our hearts; what have the words you've uttered recently told others about what's in your heart?
 - b. What have the words of others revealed to you about them?
 - c. Is the "you" you're revealing the "you" you most want to be? Is it the "you" God most wants you to be?

- 3. Gossip, deliberately lying and destructive criticism are among the deadly verbal poisons frequently uttered with devastating effect.
 - a. Are you guilty of repeating hearsay without verifying it? Why?
 - b. If asked, would others say you are an honest person? Why?
 - c. Have you ever used words with a destructive intent? Why?
- 4. Are the words of your mouth and the meditations of your heart always pleasing to the Lord? (Psalm 19:14) If not, what does that say about you?
