

"The Two-edged Sword of Christian Ministry" – August 2023
Thoughts to Ponder

Most church-going folks are familiar with Jesus' *Parable of the Good Samaritan* (Luke 10:25-37); but I suspect few have plumbed its depths to find themselves among its characters.

- 1. The parable is a response to the question: "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" (Luke 10:25)
 - a. Do you believe in eternal life? If so, what do you have to do to earn it?
 - b. Do you: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind;" and "Love your neighbor as yourself"? Explain your answer.
- 2. Neighbors were easily identifiable when I was a child.
 - a. I lived in a neighborhood; did you? If so, describe yours. If not, what do you think you missed?
 - b. How has your definition of "neighbor" changed over the years?

- 3. Have you ever become so intent on what you're doing and where you're going that you failed to notice those around you?
 - a. If so, describe the situation and the impact it had on you and those around you. If not, think again!
 - b. "If you miss the people, you miss the point." Do you agree?
- 4. Jesus' parable features four people: the man who was beaten, the priest, the Levite and the Samaritan.
 - a. Which of the characters in the parable are you striving to emulate? Why?
 - b. Which of the characters must you most closely identify with to inherit eternal life? Why?
