  - a. Who and what were your primary influences as a child? As an adult?
  - b. When did your faith journey begin and how has it progressed, if at all?

- 3. The focus of Saul's life changed dramatically in the years following his encounter with the risen Christ on the Damascus Road.
  - a. If you have become a Christian, how is your life now different? What further changes would like to embody?
  - b. The early Christians were called "Followers of the Way" would people say that name could be properly applied to you? If not, why not?
- 4. Have you ever sensed that you were headed down a dead-end street spiritually?
  - a. Were you tempted to stay the course? In what ways?
  - b. What/who opened your faith eyes to see that you really needed to make a U turn?
  - c. How hard was it to reverse course?
  - d. Please describe your life before and after you made this about face.
