- 2. The Church of the Cross is becoming a great blended family.
 - a. What is a blended family and what experience have you had with blended families?
 - b. Describe the special challenges you think members of a blended family might have to deal with.
- 3. All marriages start out with high expectations for the future.
 - a. What expectations did you have when you joined this congregation?
 - b. Over time, have some of your expectations proven to be unrealistic?
- 4. "Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience." (Colossians 3:12)
 - a. Think about your relationships with others and give examples of those that fractured because you failed to embody these virtues.
 - b. Those who gather around the Lord's Table are a motley collection of Christ wannabes. How does this statement apply to you?
- 5. "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which

binds them all together in perfect unity." (Colossians 3:13-14). How would your life be different today if you had consistently embraced this guidance from St. Paul?
