2. Do you agree that children today are much more sophisticated than they were seventy years ago?
 - a. Is that a good thing or a bad thing? Why?
 - b. How does the saying “we are too soon old and too late smart” apply to you?
 - c. Gypsy Smith had the heart and unquestioning faith of a child. Do you? If not, why not?
3. For an adult to become a childlike Christian, there is more to be unlearned about the Kingdom of God than there is to learn.
 - a. What might help you to become more of a childlike Christian?
 - b. What was the last thing you heard a preacher say about the Kingdom of God that amazed you?
 - c. Many Christians today are “playing marbles with diamonds.” Does that statement apply to you?
4. Are you striving for a peaceful coexistence with the world, the flesh and the devil or all-out victory?
 - a. What trials and hardships are you now facing?
