



The Way of the Cross: A Servant's Heart
John 13:1-17

1. What does Jesus' act of foot-washing teach us about humility and service? How does this challenge our understanding of what it means to be "great"?
2. The sermon emphasizes that Jesus washed the feet of both his devoted followers and the one who would betray him (Judas). How can we apply this kind of unconditional service and love to people who may have hurt or wronged us?
3. What role does motivation play in our acts of service? How can we ensure that our actions of serving others are not driven by recognition or guilt but by a genuine desire to follow Christ's example?

4. The sermon mentions the importance of adopting a spiritual, eternal outlook rather than a worldly definition of success. How can we shift our focus from worldly achievement to spiritual growth in our roles as servants, leaders, and followers of Christ?
