His Resurrection, Our Destiny

Read: Mark 16:1-20, Proverbs 16:9, Isaiah 46:4-5, 9-11, Romans 8:28-30

1. What detour or “wrong turn” in your life turned out to be part of God’s direction for your destiny?

The idea of personal stories where an apparent setback or mistake turned out to be God's redirection.

2. How has the Resurrection shaped the way you see your purpose and the unfolding story of your life?

The power of the Resurrection ties it to our personal destiny, reminding people that life isn't random—it's redemptive.

3. Have you ever had a “two-inch door” moment—a small detail that God used to change everything?

This opens the door for testimonies like the Mayflower halyard or Tim Keller’s story. Even the smallest things are significant in God's plan.

4. In light of Proverbs 16:9, what would it look like for you to surrender your plans today and trust God to establish your steps?

5. What part of your current life might feel accidental but could actually be God’s orchestration?
