Walking as One Sermon Notes: Ephesians 4:1-6

1. Read verse 1 of chapter 4. What do you think Paul has in mind when he talks about “calling?” How might our calling and the life of Jesus be connected?
2. One of the points from the sermon was that if we are in Christ, then how we walk should resemble Christ’s walk. What characteristics of Christ’s life do you see in the passage? What are some practical ways to grow into those characteristics?
3. The sermon also talked about how walking in a manner worthy of our calling involves walking together as a Church. Where do you see that in the passage? What could that practically look like in our church?
4. The passage talks about “maintaining” the unity of the Spirit. What do you think is the significance of the text saying maintaining rather than creating?

5. What's one takeaway for you from the sermon/passage?
